FRANCESCA ROSA

Interior Disaster is a record of a decomposing household approximately eleven months after Cyclone Larry destroyed it. With the studious intent of a forensic photographer, Francesca Rosa takes inventory of the peeling veneers and mouldy carpets as residual evidence of a crime by a powerful and mysterious perpetrator.

Emerging artist Francesca Rosa grew up in Innisfail, Queensland and witnessed first hand the devastation Larry caused. *Interior Disaster* forms part of a larger body of work that focuses on the uncomfortable relationship between people and their environments in various locations throughout Far North Queensland.
